## **GUARNERI STRING QUARTET – PUBLICITY BREAKS**

## 9 MAY 2001, CARNEGIE HALL CONCERT AND ARRIVAL OF PETER WILEY NANCY SHEAR ARTS SERVICES REPORT, AS OF 4 SEPTEMBER 2001

We wrote and distributed press releases (many with photos) to 223 media representatives, and have done substantial telephone follow-up with all of the important ones. News might have broken in several publications and in the broadcast media without our knowing this (we did not recommend engaging a clipping service as they are very expensive and miss a high percentage of media breaks). We have arranged for virtually all of the major media to do stories and/or interviews.

We asked that Carnegie Hall use our press release, which stressed the new era for the Quartet – the future, not the past. Carnegie Hall's original release said "Guarneri String Quartet Makes Its Final New York Appearance..." Ours said "Guarneri String Quartet Begins New Era..." We did this to put to rest any doubts that the Quartet would continue, and would do so in good health. We made certain that the bio in the press release included information about the new recording label, Surroundedby Entertainment.

<u>Associated Press</u> – Did a major, 1000-word story with their own photo shoot, which broke on May 3. This was available to 1500 newspapers in the U. S. and additional publications abroad.

Since the Quartet would not be together, we had to turn this down. We also arranged for two members of the Quartet to appear on the show on May 18, but the producer wanted all four members. We have asked them to extend their invitation to the

autumn, when the Quartet will benefit from New York media exposure for the new season, and the new membership.
